

KMS Uniform Policy

2016-2017

The school uniform policy is designed to provide students with the safest and most orderly learning environment possible.

Shirts:

Polo shirts that are grade level color are required. Long or short sleeve polo shirts are acceptable. Shirts may not have any logos other than the KMS logo.

6th Grade- Red Polo Shirt

7th Grade- Royal Blue Polo Shirt

8th Grade- Navy Blue Polo Shirt

Undershirts:

Undershirts that are worn must be a solid color with no visible graphics. (Long/short sleeves) Undershirts may not extend below the uniform top in length.

Bottoms:

Navy blue or Khaki material pants, shorts, capris, and skirts are acceptable. Pants are worn at waistline with no rips, tears, or logos. Shorts/skirts should be no more than 2 inches above the knee. No navy or khaki jeans, leggings/pants made of stretchy material may be worn. Solid color tights may be worn under a skirt or jumper.

Sweaters/Sweatshirts/Fleece:

Grade Level Color with no logos other than Knox logo can be worn. Polo collar should be visible under sweater/sweatshirt/fleece. Knox hoodies and royal blue Knox sweatshirts may be worn at any grade level.

Jackets/Coats:

Jackets/Coats will be placed in a student's locker at the beginning of the day and retrieved upon dismissal.

Shoes/Socks:

Shoes must be enclosed at both heel and toe. Shoes with laces must be tied. Socks should not be worn over the pants legs.

Accessories and Other Items:

All hats and head coverings are removed upon arrival to school. Jewelry is discreet and non-disruptive to the learning environment. Winter wear (hat, toboggan, gloves, scarf, etc.) should be stored in locker upon arrival to school.

Bags of any kind will not be allowed in classrooms. When a student arrives to school pocketbooks, handbags, cinch sacks, and book bags will be placed in the locker. Students will be allowed to get items for PE from their lockers during locker break at exploratory time.

The administration reserves the right to address any dress code concern that presents itself as a distraction to students/teachers and is disruptive to the learning environment. This policy can be changed or modified at any point and students/teachers/ parents will be notified.
